Danielle is also highly involved with her church with her role being the program co-ordinator.

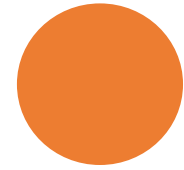

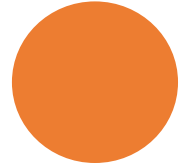
